West Shelter House Terms and Conditions City of Wakefield

Please read carefully! Keep this page for your information.

- The rental applications must be accompanied by a \$70.00 damage deposit payable by check. The damage deposit will be held until a complete inspection is made following use of the shelter house. Charges for excessive cleanup, damage and/or replacement of items will be deducted from the deposit. If such charges are in excess of the deposit, a bill for the balance will be issued and be payable by the user.
- 2. It is the responsibly of the party making the reservations to pick up the entrance key on the date of the reservation between 8:00am and 4:00pm at the city office. Those making reservations for Saturday or Sunday must pick up the key on the preceding Friday by 4:00pm.
- 3. All setup and cleanup is to be completed during the specified rental time period.
- 4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the shelter house or Graves Park.
- 5. Smoking is not allowed in the shelter house.
- 6. Use of tape, tacks or nails to attach decorations to walls or ceiling is prohibited. The use of poster gum for that purpose is permitted.
- 7. Available equipment: 6 ft. plastic tables- 8
 - Chairs- 52 Picnic tables -6 Sink & water Electrical Outlets Heating and Cooling Kitchen Appliances-stove, refrigerator w/ freezer Charcoal grill Trash containers with liners
- 8. If cooking in the kitchen, the rental party will be responsible for supplying all utensils, paper goods and cleaning towels.
- Tables and chairs need to be cleaned and stacked. Floors need to be swept and cleared of debris. Please mop up any spills. Brooms and a mop are available. Cleaning supplies are located under the sink.
- 10. If kitchen has been used all counter tops, sink and stove top shall be cleaned. All stove burners and ovens shall be turned off.
- 11. The party using the shelter house shall, following completion of use, secure all windows, lock all doors, turn off heating/cooling equipment and turn off all lights.
- 12. Rental party is responsible for removing all trash from the shelter house. All trash should be placed in the green dumpsters near the parking area.
- 13. Charcoal grill-please make sure all hot coal are extinguished before leaving shelter house.
- 14. All items left in shelter house will be disposed of.
